Kindergarten Registration

It is hard to believe it is almost that time again! Registration for the 2020-2021 school year opens on <u>January 8, 2020</u>. Families interested in French Immersion for their incoming Kindergarten student will need to apply between <u>January 8, 2020 and January 31, 2020</u> to be included in the French Immersion lottery. Families who currently have siblings attending Pauline Haarer will receive priority placement, as long as you have registered within the above timeframe. If you do not register within that timeframe, your child will be placed on the waitlist. Unfortunately, if the sibling is currently enrolled is in Grade 7, your incoming Kindergarten student will not receive priority placement.
