History

Over fifteen years ago from one feeling four people gathered with a simple intent: to make people living on the street smile at Christmas. They put together 88 care packages and ran down the back alleys of downtown Edmonton. They hung them from garbage bins to let people know that they were not alone. Overnight 88 bags disappeared, and EDAS was born.

Today

Today, with the help of local community members EDAS reaches thousands of people living on the streets. Each gift bag is hand painted, and is filled with; a homemade Christmas card, fresh baked cookies and warm clothing. EDAS partners with various school districts across British Columbia, to inspire students to lead their communities to love and connect with those homeless.
