Energy Cup

Ecole Pauline Haarer is participating for the first time in the SD68 Energy Cup. Our goal is to reduce our carbon footprint by conserving energy. Some of the initiatives we will be doing through December to February are:

- Dim the Lights we are remembering to use daylight and/or half of the rooms lights where possible.
- Turn it off we are remembering to turn off the lights and electronics when we leave a room.
- Sweater Days we are reducing the heat in our school through December and January. Students and staff are reminded to wear sweaters.
- Close the blinds we are remembering to close the blinds in each room at the end of the day to reduce heat lost through windows.

It is that time of year again! Registration for next year is coming up in January.

If you are going to Grade 8 next year, please see the information below:

- If you are planning on attending NDSS
 French Immersion in September 2022, your registration will automatically be done by Ecole Pauline Haarer.
- If you are planning on attending NDSS
 English in September 2022, we will register your child and you must contact NDSS directly.
- If you are planning on attending NDSS Academies in September 2022, you must register online at www.sd68.bc.ca/programs/secondaryacademies before March 1, 2022. Please note that academy spots will be determined by lottery or try-out/auditions. For more information, please contact NDSS directly.
- If you are <u>not</u> planning on attending NDSS in September 2022, please register online

at <u>www.sd68.bc.ca</u> for your school of preference.

If you are starting Kindergarten next year, please see the information below:

Do you have a child eligible to begin Kindergarten in September 2022, and have another student currently attending Ecole Pauline Haarer? If you do...

- We will hold a space in Kindergarten for your child
- Your registration will not be entered into the lottery

However, to hold that space, you must:

- Complete the online registration form (<u>www.sd68.bc.ca</u>) which will be available from January 5-31, 2022.
- Email the school secretary, Jennifer Mile, at jmile@sd68.bc.ca; with your child's name and the sibling's name currently attending Ecole Pauline Haarer.

If you do not register by January 31, 2022, you will lose your Kindergarten spot and it will be added to the lottery.
