We have had a staffing update this month. Ecole Pauline Haarer would like to welcome Mme. Sywak. Mme. Sywak will be our new school secretary for the remainder of this year.

The Student Learning/Satisfaction Survey is currently underway. This survey is mandated by the Ministry of Education for all Grades 4 & 7 students, at the elementary level. Parents of these grade students will also be asked to participate in the survey. A letter has already been distributed to students to take home to their parents. If you have not yet received it, please contact the classroom teacher or the office. Staff at Ecole Pauline Haarer are also asked to complete the survey. The data collected helps us to plan for next year.

Mid Year Written Progress Reports will be coming home to families on February 10th, 2023 via email. This means that teachers are busy completing them now. We encourage all students to continue to work hard and ensure that all assignments are completed well and are handed in. The written comments and a sliding scale are the two important components of this document. Supplementary documentation will be emailed to families separately on the same distribution day. For questions about your child's learning progression, please speak to the classroom teacher.

Registration for next year is currently underway also. If you have a student attending Kindergarten next September or a student moving to Grade 8, please see the information below regarding the registration process, the lottery system and Secondary Academy options. Secondary School Course Selection is underway. Ecole Pauline Haarer welcomed NDSS this past week with a presentation from one of their counselors.

Registration 2023-24

Kindergarten Registration

Registration for the 2023-2024 school year is underway online as of <u>Wednesday January 4th at 8:00</u> <u>am and ends Tuesday, January 31st, 2023.</u> ALL families interested in French Immersion for their incoming Kindergarten student(s) need to apply online by the deadline.

If you currently have a child who will attend Pauline Haarer again during the 2023-24 school year, you can have a kindergarten spot saved for their younger sibling(s)! To ensure a spot is saved for your kindergarten aged child(ren), you **MUST** register online before January 31st. If you do not register within that time frame, a spot will not be held for your child, and your child(ren) will be placed on a waitlist.

Unfortunately, if you have a child who is currently enrolled in Grade 7, your incoming Kindergarten student will not have a spot held for them. Your kindergarten aged child(ren) will be included in the lottery; providing that you apply before the lottery closes on January 31st, 2023.

Grade 8 registration for our current Grade 7 students

If your child plans to attend NDSS_for Grade 8, you do not need to re-register. All grade 7 students from Pauline Haarer school are automatically set up to attend NDSS for their grade 8 school year. *However, if your child is registering for an Academy, even an NDSS academy, then you must please complete the online registration form.* Some academies are determined by lottery and some by audition. Registration deadline for the Academies is March 1, 2023.

If your child is *not planning to* attend NDSS *for Grade 8,* please complete an online registration form for the school of your choice.

Registration opens on January 4th, 2023.

Dress for the Weather

We would like to remind parents that we expect the children to go outside to play during our recess breaks. This is a healthy activity. Thank you for sending your child(ren) to school prepared to be outside in the cold, wet winter conditions.

School Closure due to Inclement Weather

It is that time of year again when the school district would like to remind parents about school closure procedures. The most common reason that schools might be closed are dangerous road conditions due to a heavy snowfall or ice.

If you are wondering if schools are open on a particular day, for the most current updates listen to the local radio (WAVE 102.3 FM and WOLF 106.9 FM) in the mornings.

We also attempt to put an announcement of any school closure on the school district website (<u>www.sd68.bc.ca</u>), Twitter and Facebook, but our ability to do so could be affected by such things as power outages and technical issues. If there is no announcement on the website or social media, please be sure to listen to local radio stations.

We would like to remind parents that it is their right to make the final decision as to whether it is safe for their children to travel to school on any given day. While the district strives to make the best decision possible for students across the district, there may be circumstances in your neighbourhood that lead you to decide to keep your child(ren) home, even though schools are open.
